

## Nations in the Caribbean and South America. (2 Chronicles 7: 13—14)

### **Pray for:**

1. Revival in the Church in the Caribbean for the evangelization and transformation of nations like Jamaica, Trinidad & Tobago, Guyana, and Venezuela that continue to experience a high level of violent crimes. In the case of Venezuela, street gangs and organized crime run rampant making it one of the deadliest in the world. Due to the economic crisis facing Venezuela roughly 4 million people have already fled the nation and more is expected to follow.

2. The Governments of the region in their continued fight against rising corruption, international drug trafficking and international human trafficking (a \$32 billion global industry); rising unemployment due to economic declines, rising food and fuel prices;

3. The nation of Haiti, facing political instability resulting from the recent assassination of its president and severe economic hardship resulting from the recent earthquake that killed over 2200 people. It is estimated that the quake has affected over 1.2 Million people, more than half of whom are children.

### The European Continent (1 Sam. 7:2-6):

### **Pray for:**

1. Revival in the church across Europe.

While Christianity has been steadily declining, Islam has been growing rapidly and replacing the Christian influence. A recent survey in the UK, for example, has found that 9 out of 10 Christians in the UK believe their faith is being marginalized. While Islam continues to thrive in the UK and elsewhere across Europe, the greatest threat to Christianity on the continent, however, appears to be secular humanism, which has continued to undermine the influence of the traditional church. Christian persecution has also been on the rise across the continent. Pentecostal congregations, particularly from the African and Caribbean immigrant populations continue to experience growth, however. Spiritual revivals are also being reported among churches in East Germany that cater largely to Iranian refugees.

2. Solutions to the growing refugee crisis across Europe, including Christian refugees facing discrimination. Recent surveys by Open Doors found that 75% of Christian refugees in Germany claimed to have been persecuted by fellow Muslim refugees and security staff.

### The African Continent (2 Chron. 20:3-25)

### **Pray for:**

1. The continued growth of the church in Africa and for the revival being experienced on the continent to influence real change and transformation of African societies.

Africa's 31.1 million food-deprived masses scattered across Sudan's Darfur region, Zimbabwe, Ethiopia, Uganda and elsewhere, pose a major challenge for the continent. Despite progress in boosting democracy, ending wars, and economic growth, Africa is the only region in the world becoming less and less able to feed itself. Reasons include the relentless spread of desert.

2. Resolution of religious conflicts and the defeat of terrorism threatening various African states, including Nigeria, Somalia, Cameroon and Niger where Al-Qaida and Boko Haram, have established a foothold. It has been reported recently that in the Cameroon and Niger several hundreds of the members of Boko Haram have been defecting from the terrorist group. Pray for the complete dissolution of the group.

### The Middle East and Israel (Joel 2:15, 18-19, 24-26)

### **Pray for:**

1. The Christian community in the Middle East facing economic hardship and persecution

According to a recent report, economic hardships, armed conflict, and persecution have long been catalysts for the exodus of Christians from the Middle East. Over the past few decades these pressures have steadily reduced the proportion of Christians in the Middle East from around 20 percent at the start of the 20th century to around 5 percent now. Less than 1 percent of the world's more than 2 billion Christians live in the Middle East, and there are fears that number could dwindle even further. Since the 2011 war in Syria the Christian population has declined by more than 50% and that in Iraq by more than 80% since the 2003 US invasion.

2. A solution to the Syrian refugee crisis, considered the worst in history since the last world war. In 2016, the United Nations (UN) identified 13.5 million Syrians requiring humanitarian assistance, of which about 6.7 million are internally displaced within Syria, and 6.2 million are refugees outside of Syria. Half of those affected are children.

3. Peaceful solution to the Israeli/Palestinian conflict in keeping with God's plan for both Israel and the Palestinian people.

### Asia, the Largest and Most Populous Continent: (2 Cor. 1:1-11)

Asia comprises a full 30% of the world's land area with 60% of the world's current population or 4.4 billion people. Asia also has the vast majority of unreached peoples, comprising the majority of the world's Muslims, Hindus, and Buddhists. Asia contains some of the worst countries in the world when it comes to Christian persecution. These countries include, North Korea, India and China. Asia also has over 80% of the world's poorest people.

### **Pray for:**

1. The church, its leaders and organizations, will network together to fulfill the Great Commission.

2. The continued growth of China's church movement, despite increased persecution, and for its impact on the rest of Asia;

3. Unity of Christians in China, Korea and Japan for the revival of North East Asia and the whole of Asia

4. Protection and Greater freedom of Christians in North Korea, where the government views Christianity as the number one enemy of the state. An estimated 300,000 live in North Korea of which 50,000 are serving harsh prison terms in concentration camps for their faith in Christ.

5. Protection of women and other minority groups at extreme risk of being targeted with deadly violence in Afghanistan

Among the communities at risk of being targeted with deadly violence are "an estimated ten thousand Christians, many of whom are 'guilty' of converting from Islam — a crime punishable by death under Sharia law," (The Christian Post, August 2021). It is estimated that over 500,000 persons could flee Afghanistan as a result of the Taliban re-gaining control of the nation suffering from extreme poverty.

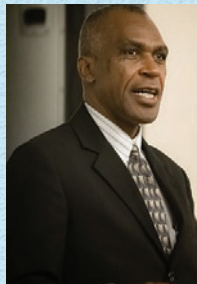

## Prayer for Solutions to the Covid-19 Pandemic (Matthew 6:13; Psalm 91:1 –16)

The COVID-19 Pandemic is placing significant burdens on the shoulders of nations worldwide to find immediate solutions to the unprecedented health challenges posed by the Pandemic and the socio-economic consequences that could result if these challenges are not adequately managed. Prayer for the governments of nations at the forefront of the battle against the Pandemic is probably the most important thing the Church can provide at this time. Other critical areas for prayer include (i) the media, given its critical role in the public dissemination of information and in helping to keep governments accountable to their citizens; (ii) Healthcare workers and other first responders; (iii) the family, and particularly children.

### Pray for

1. Leaders of governments to receive wisdom and direction to continue managing the crisis of their nations effectively and that biblical values of justice, honesty, and fairness may prevail in these decisions. Pray against all arrogance of governments will give way to humility. Pray especially for the preservation of religious liberty, particularly in nations opposed to Christianity,
2. Scientists and researchers who provide advice to governments on the COVID-19 Pandemic, including the COVID-19 vaccine, that their reports will be accurate resulting in impartial, workable and effective policy decisions to help safeguard the health, as well as, the social and economic wellbeing of nations during this Pandemic.
3. Christians to become more aware of the reality that we live in a media-saturated society and to avoid becoming confused by inaccurate information put out by the media about the Pandemic and to become knowledgeable of the facts
4. Compassionate ministry of the Church to be extended at this time of crisis to those families severely impacted by the Pandemic.
5. The importance of the family unit as the first place where we express our faith through times of prayer and Bible reading as a family will be strongly emphasized and recognized during this Pandemic. Pray also for students at the various levels of the education system that have been negatively affected by frequent isolation and lack of in-person learning.
6. The protection of all healthcare professionals, including doctors and nurses in the various nations around the world working to contain the virus, and to treat those infected. Pray for the supernatural release of strength, love and compassion among these healthcare professionals providing care to the hundreds of people infected and dying daily in nations with significant infection and death rates.

## The United States of America: (1Tim. 2: 1 – 6.Psalm 51: 1-19)

### *1. The US Government*

#### **Pray for**

- (i) President Joe Biden and his family; all members of his Cabinet and White House staff, for their safety, protection, and wisdom to govern the country justly and in the fear of God.
- (ii) the love, peace, and unity of God to permeate all areas of our deeply divided US Government to facilitate healing and reconciliation in all sectors of American life.
- (iii) Solutions to US immigration problems, including the growing crisis at the US southern border.

### **2. The Church**

#### **Pray for Revival in the church across America.**

Consider these three critical issues as you pray:

- (i) Chronic lack of church growth marked by low rates of retention and evangelism. It's estimated that 42 million young people could leave the church by 2050. That is over one million young people walking away from the church each year. If, however, we can revert to Gen X rates of retention and evangelism, that number can be reduced to only 20 million. It is also estimated that 176,000 churches could close by 2050 in the US if the trend continues.

- (ii) A culture of death marked by a high suicide and abortions rates.

Suicide is the 10th leading cause of death in the US. 47,173 Americans committed suicide in 2017, but there were an estimated 1,400,000 suicide attempts in the year. In 2015 suicide and self-inflicted injuries cost the Federal Government \$69 billion. But the sad news is that the suicide rate is trending upwards, an indication of the high level of hopelessness permeating every sector of American culture.

More than 61 million abortions have been performed in the United States since 1973 when the U.S. Supreme Court's Roe v. Wade decision made the procedure legal. For the same period, the number of abortions committed worldwide is estimated at 16 million. Fewer U.S. women are having abortions than at any time since Roe v. Wade, according to new government figures. In 2015, the most recent year for which data is available, a total of 638,169 abortions were reported, a decrease of 2 percent from 652,639 abortions in 2014.

- (iii) Moral decay marked by racial and political division "America's ills are not the result of racism or corruption, although these are evil. Our troubles can also be traced directly to ineffective Christians" (Tony Evans).

#### **Pray for**

A spirit of repentance upon the church across America. Repentance for the various sins that have led the Christian Community across America to become so deeply divided. Repentance for the racial and political divisions manifesting in the nation and for Christians across America to display humility and a true spirit of repentance towards God.
